

Important note from the Youth Subcommittee:

As we approach winter, UPY has started meeting indoors when conditions do not allow outdoor gatherings. Just like our outdoor gatherings, we will continue to mask, wash hands, and maintain social distance as well as avoid sharing food, drink, or materials. FUPC employs a great cleaning service that sanitized gathering spaces between gatherings. A full copy of the UPY Cold Weather Policy is available upon request.

We have started keeping attendance at UPY events to help with contact tracing, but we are placing the ownership on you to not attend if you are unwell. We are using the same self-screening questions as Fayetteville Public Schools:

Have you experience ANY of the currently known symptoms of COVID-19 below in the past 48 hours?

- **a fever of 100.4F or greater?**
- **a cough?**
- **difficulty breathing?**
- **a sore throat?**
- **a new loss of the sensation of taste or smell?**
- **close* contact with a person known to be infected with Covid-19 in the previous 14 days?**

**Close contact is defined as being within approximately 6 feet of a Covid-19 positive case for greater than 15 minutes; close contact can occur while caring for, living with, visiting, or sharing a healthcare waiting area*

or room with a Covid-19 case or having direct contact with infectious secretions of a Covid-19 case (e.g., being coughed on)

If you answer yes to any of these questions, we ask that you do not attend UPY that day.
