**CEO UPDATE:** In the first 3 months of 2026, Cooperative Emergency Outreach (CEO) assisted 1,609 family members: checks to providers totaled \$53,338 and food to families totaled \$35,546. FUPC donations to CEO totaled \$7,061. **Here are some ways you can help:**
